WALKING SCHOOL BUS (WSB) POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

Program Policies

- Only children registered for both the Boys and Girls Club Program and WSB program may participate.
- Each WSB will be led by at least TPS staff or TPS volunteers.
- Children will be walked from Keyser Elementary to the Boys and Girls Club after school on their registered days only.
- Children must obey all instructions given by WSB and leaders, and adhere to all safety policies.
- Children must be picked up at the Boys and Girls Club by 7:30pm.
- Photographs of children may be used in promotional materials.

Safety Policies and Rules

- Stay together and walk on the sidewalk
- Walk and do not run.
- Behave sensibly (no horsing around).
- Be respectful: use appropriate language at all times
- Cross streets and intersections as a group.

Consequences for breaking any safety policies or rules: The safety of all students is our top priority. Any student not adhering to the policies and rules are at risk of IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE PROGRAM.

Cancellation and Absenteeism Policies

Bad Weather - children should always dress appropriately

The WSB Coordinator will cancel the WSB if:

- They are ill and unable to safely perform job
- The temperature drops below 32 F.
- It is raining hard enough to wet children's clothes.
- There is a severe weather warning in the area.

The WSB Coordinator will contact each participating family by 2:00pm via email or text if the WSB is cancelled. (please make sure your contact info. is updated)

If your child does not attend school or is sent home early from school, they may not participate in the WSB that day.

If your child will not be walking with the WSB in the PM:

You should make every effort to contact the WSB coordinator by 2:00pm.
